The following is what Road and Track has shared:

"It has been more than eight years since the current Nissan 370Z, shown above, went on sale, but Nissan's legendary Z-car soon will get its long-awaited redesign. The first major step will be taken at the Tokyo auto show this fall, where Nissan will reveal the next-generation Z concept, a preview of the production car said to offer several potent power-trains.

It is expected that the new Z concept and production car will have similar proportions to the

outgoing coupe. The Z will also adopt an edgier styling language, including a gaping front end that takes cues from the latest GT-R facelift, and will ride on a shorter wheelbase courtesy of the Infiniti Q60's FR-L platform.

Of the three powertrains offered, the flagship twin-turbocharged 3.0-liter V-6, borrowed from the Infiniti Q60 Red Sport, is said to punch out a healthy 400 horsepower at 6400 rpm and 350 lb-ft of torque at 1600 rpm; it will be mated to a seven-speed dual-clutch automatic transmission. If this version lives up to those expectations, it could put the Nissan toe to toe with rivals such as Porsche's 718 Boxster S and BMW's M2.

In addition to the entry-level 3.0-liter V-6, generating 300 horsepower and 295 lb-ft, we also hear that Nissan is working on a hybridized model to be introduced later that could make the Z the most powerful in its class. It is expected to employ the same 3.0-liter V-6, teamed with a dual-clutch gearbox and an electric motor producing as much as 160 horses. One source told us that this model's total output could reach an eye-popping 500 horsepower. The new Z is expected to land in showrooms by 2019, with the base model priced in the low-\$30,000 range and the twin-turbo nearing \$50,000."

I won't be making it to the Chicago Auto Show, so you all will need to update me on what you see. I hear Nissan doesn't have a Z there this year. The big focus is the Rogue 1 movie tie-in. I'll see you all at the General WCZC meeting in March. Kristian should be updating you on the schedule, for our next club events in his column.

Midwest Z Heritage Fest will be hosted by the Great Lakes Z Club. This is newer Z Club and this is the first time they will be hosting. They said the event will include some track

time. They are working on the details. So far, all I know is it will be in mid south Michigan and one of the last weekends in July.

ZATTACK 2017 Nissan Z Car Show & Open Cruise-In

The Middle Tennessee Z Club and Nissan North America, Inc. are pleased to announce that ZATTACK 2017

will be held Friday and Saturday, April 21-22, in the Nashville area

For those who have not participated in previous ZATTACKs, we promise a fun-filled two days for Nissan fans and gear heads in general. This is a great opportunity to meet members of the Nissan and Z car enthusiast community and also take in the sights and sounds of Music City USA.

The events begin Friday afternoon, April 21 at 3 pm with a tour of the Nissan vehicle manufacturing facility in Smyrna, TN. This award-winning plant produces the Nissan Altima, Maxima, Pathfinder, Rogue, all-electric LEAF and the Infiniti QX60. Annual capacity is 640,000 units. Smyrna tours are limited to 50 people so please register early. Registration for ZATTACK 2017 is required.

Friday evening the Middle Tennessee Z Club will host a catered BBQ dinner and exclusive private tour at the Lane Motor Museum (<http://lanemotormuseum.org>) in Nashville from 6:30 – 9 pm. The Lane houses part of the Nissan Heritage Collection, most of which are not normally available for public viewing. In addition, the museum's eclectic collection of 150+ mainly European automobiles, motorcycles and oddities will entertain and amuse! Space is limited for this private event and registration for ZATTACK 2017 is required.

The ZATTACK 2017 People's Choice Car Show will be Saturday, April 22, in Franklin, TN at the Nissan Americas building, the U.S. corporate headquarters for Nissan North America from 8 am – 3 pm. All registered ZATTACK entrants receive a ballot to vote for the winners. Awards will be given to the top three places for all generations of Z cars in Stock, Modified and Ultra-Modified classes. Additional awards will be given for Diamond in the Rough and Best in Show.

A new OPEN class invites Datsun, Nissan and Infiniti vehicles of any year to compete for "Top Five" honors. Potential entries include Skylines, Datsun roadsters, G37 coupes, GT-Rs and of course Altimas and Maximas.

Nissan will also host a cruise-in which is open to the public for all vehicle makes and models. No registration or fee is required for cruise-in exhibitors and spectators. We expect a huge turnout for this and based on past events, the variety of cars will be fantastic! Nissan will also exhibit new models, prototypes, show cars and Nissan Heritage Collection vehicles.

Spectators are welcome. There is plenty of parking available. In the event of rain, the show will be moved to the parking garage.
