

Greetings Fellow Z-ites,

The BIG NEWS for June is, of course the Midwest Z Heritage Show in Nashville, TN. If this were an article in Variety the headline would read: *WCZC BOFFO AT Z FEST IN N'VILLE!* But I'm getting ahead of the story. On June 15, 4 Zs met at the Lincoln Oasis (the Oppermans, Johnsons, Kreitlings and Ty Ozgen) for the journey to Nashville. We would be joined there by the Pleiters, Kushs, Kecas, Rosecrans and Mike Phillips who traveled separately. The caravan journey was largely uneventful with the exception of a slight detour which may have been caused by someone who looked like me. The lane change turned out to be one going to Columbus, OH instead of Columbus, IN. No great delay and Bill Opperman had a chance to refuel so we were on our way in no time albeit one of us was a bit red faced.

The Fest was held at Season's Lodge and was attended by about 100 people and 50+ Zs with all generations being represented. Notably absent this year were any Infinitys or GTRs. 
